DECLARATION PURSUANT TO LAW SOCIETY RULE 2.22

I, _____, of _____ in the Province of _____, DO SOLEMNLY DECLARE AND UNDERTAKE:

1. That I have requested the Benchers of the Law Society of Newfoundland and Labrador to exempt me from the requirement that I maintain in effect Professional Liability Insurance.
2. That I will not practise law for any person other than the government of the province, or an agency of the Crown in right of the province, effective _____.
3. That should I decide to carry on the practice of law or practise law for any person other than the government of the province, or an agency of the Crown in right of the province, I will forthwith advise the Benchers of the Law Society of Newfoundland and Labrador and obtain Professional Liability Insurance **prior** to such a change in practice.
4. That should I maintain or operate a trust account, I will immediately advise the Benchers of the Law Society of Newfoundland and Labrador of the existence of such trust account and the reasons for the continued maintenance and operation of the trust account.
5. That I acknowledge that, should I be exempted from maintaining Professional Liability Insurance, I will not claim any indemnity from the Law Society of Newfoundland and Labrador or its insurers for any claims made against me for any act or omission which takes place during the period I have been so exempted.
6. That the information provided herein is accurate.
