This seminar will include the following presentations:

1. Hot Issues in Spousal and Child Support

The Revised User's Guide to the Spousal Support Advisory Guidelines came out in April 2016. It offers help on some hot issues, like compensatory and non-compensatory entitlement, income determination, post-separation income increases, variation and review, repartnering, retirement, and exceptions. Hot issues in child support include shared custody, step-parents, adult children and s.7 expenses.

2. Family Law Rules Revision

This session is intended to provide lawyers appearing on family law matters in the Supreme Court General Division and Family Division with a briefing on the upcoming amendments to Rule 56A. In particular, the presenters will review certain new processes and procedures introduced to promote resolution without the need for a full trial. There will be additional authority given to judges at a Case Management Meeting, restrictions on the use of temporary applications (now referred to as Interim Applications) as well as the introduction of a Summary Judgment process, hearings to determine certain factual or legal issues, the possible use of Binding Settlement conferences, and newly designed Court forms.
