General Discussion about Strategic Work Plan

The Executive Director referred Benchers to the existing Strategic Work Plan that is posted on the portal. She noted that some access to justice initiatives will likely be on the next work plan, but other priorities may be removed from the plan or reformulated.

She highlighted that strategic planning occurred in November and that Benchers would be presented with a report from the facilitator of the planning session, Allan Fineblit. The report is anticipated to be distributed before Christmas and placed on the February Benchers' Meeting agenda for discussion.

The report will help inform the next work plan, but Benchers may decide to include or omit any of the suggestions included in the plan. Once Benchers determine the appropriate initiatives, the Executive Director will help identify the resources that may be necessary to accomplish the initiatives. A final work plan will then be prepared for Benchers' consideration and approval.

The Vice-President noted that he and General Counsel attended a Zoom meeting with representatives from the Supreme Court relating to digital access and enhancements at the Supreme Court. He added that it was a quick but productive discussion.
