Mandate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monitor and review all proposed and approved amendments to the Model Code of Professional Conduct provided by the Federation of Law Societies of Canada’s Standing Committee on the Model Code of Professional Conduct.
Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet as needed to provide feedback to the Standing Committee on the Model Code of Professional Conduct on proposed amendments to the Model Code of Professional Conduct; and • Make recommendations to Benchers for changes to the Code of Professional Conduct, following a review of the approved amendments to the Model Code of Professional Conduct provided by the Standing Committee on the Model Code of Professional Conduct.
Reporting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Report to the Benchers: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ when a vacancy occurs; and ○ as needed.
Staff Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Director of Professional Responsibility and the Professional Responsibility Administrator, at the discretion of the Executive Director.
